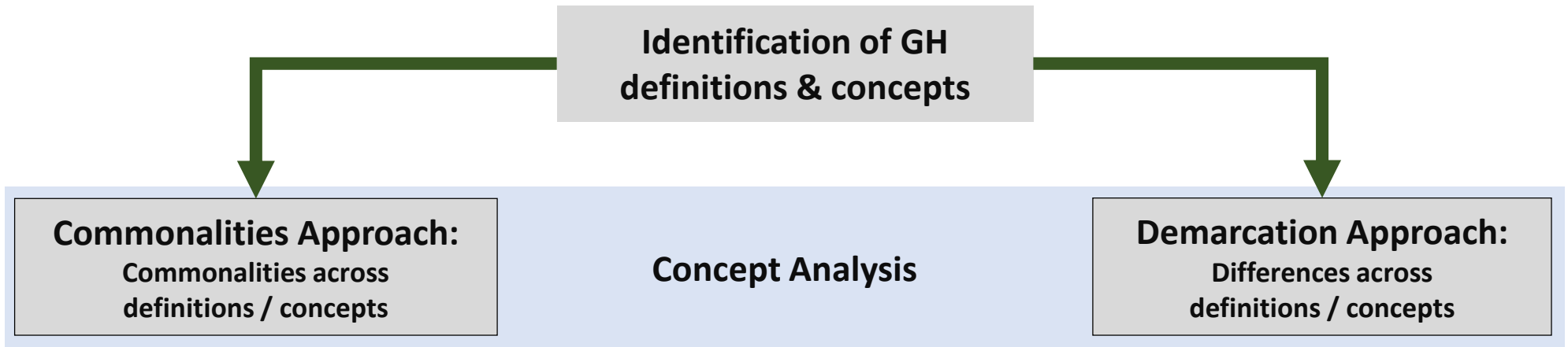

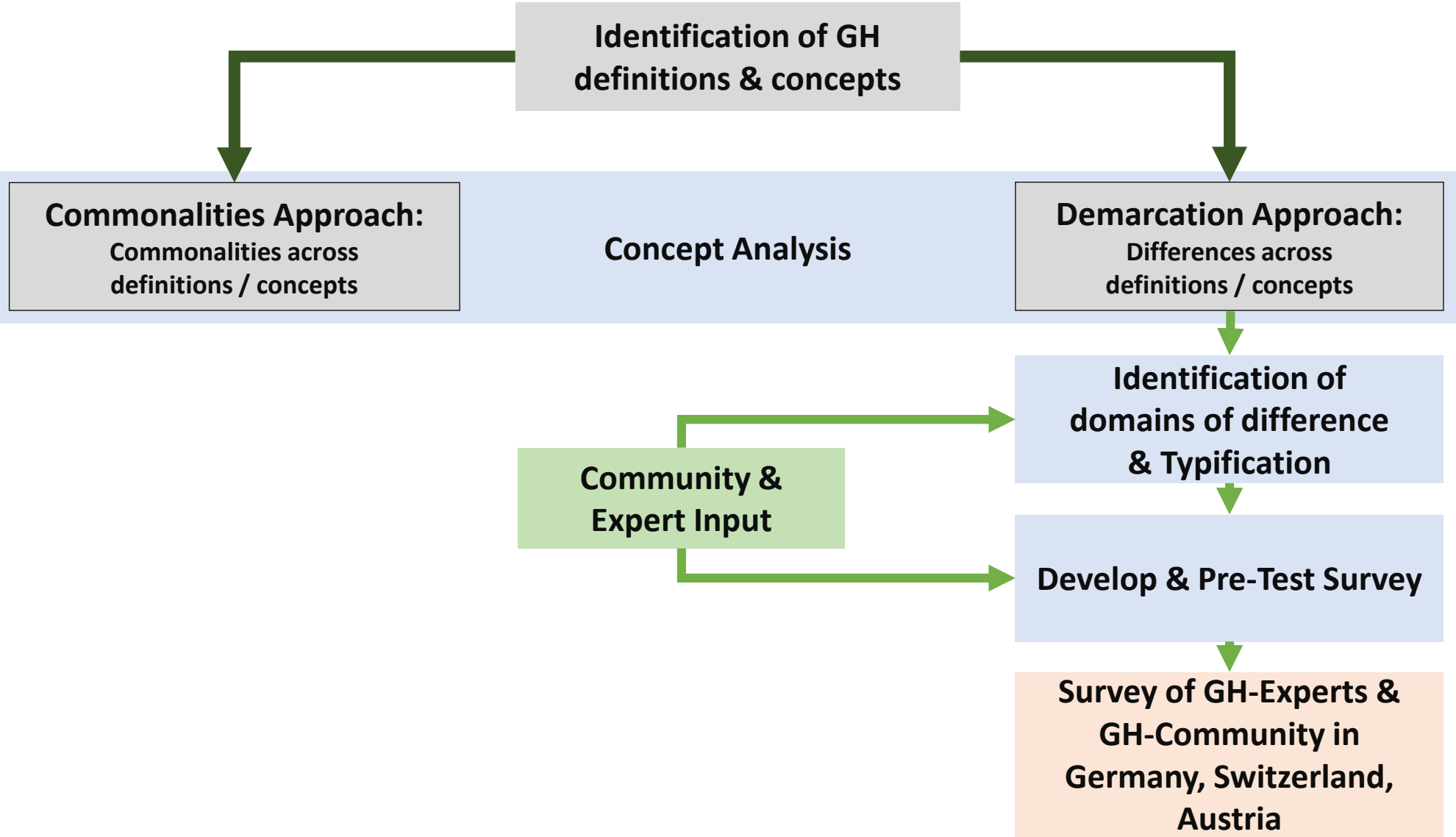

Identification of GH definitions & concepts

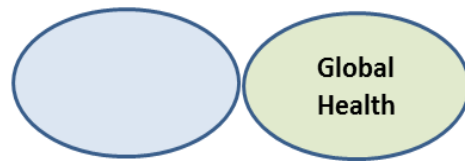
- Systematic identification of theoretical & conceptual studies providing and/or discussing definitions and/or concepts of Global Health

 - Hand search of references of included studies

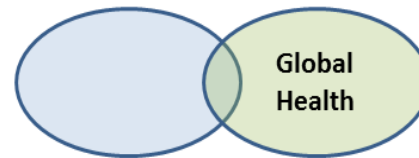


Mapping of Global Health Definitions & Concepts

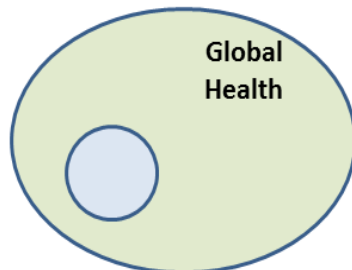
2. Minor overlap



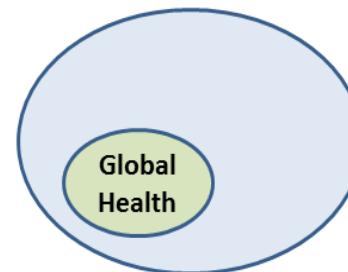
3. Substantial overlap

5. Field is part of Global Health

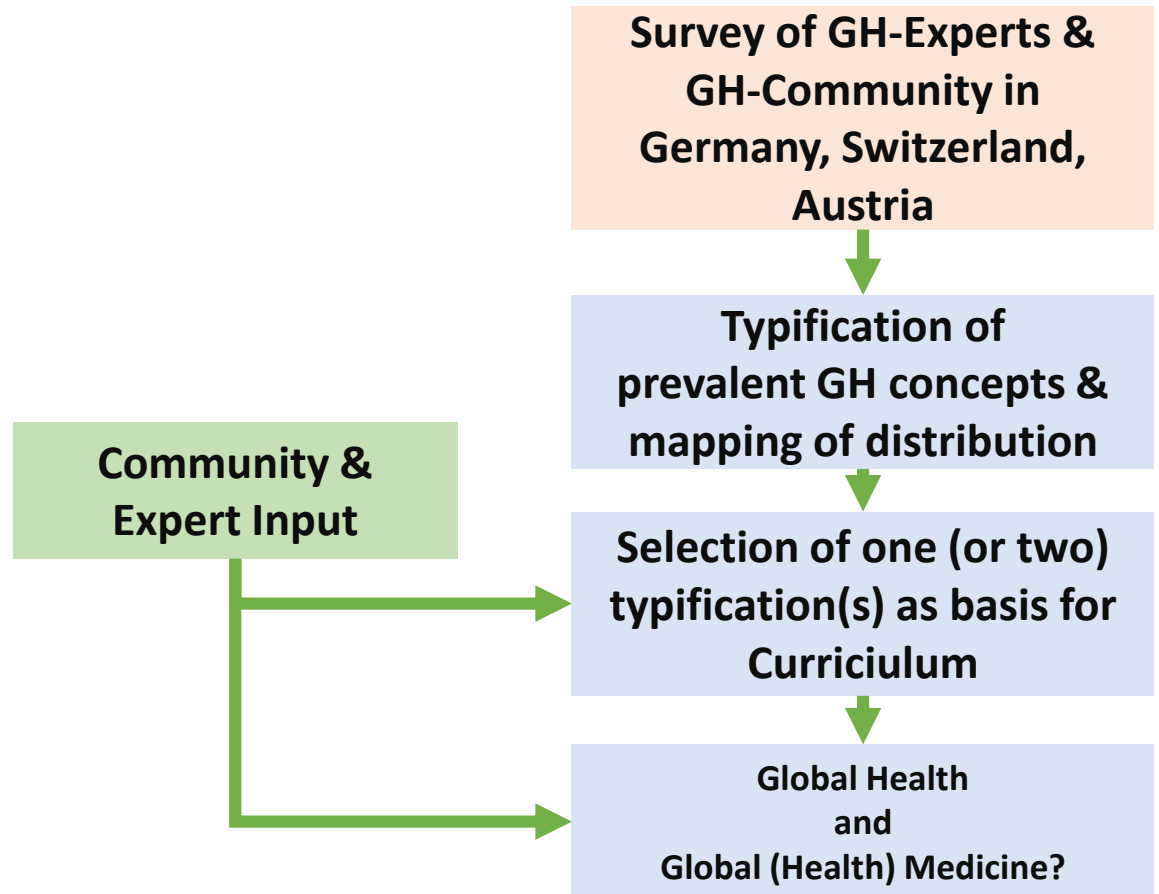
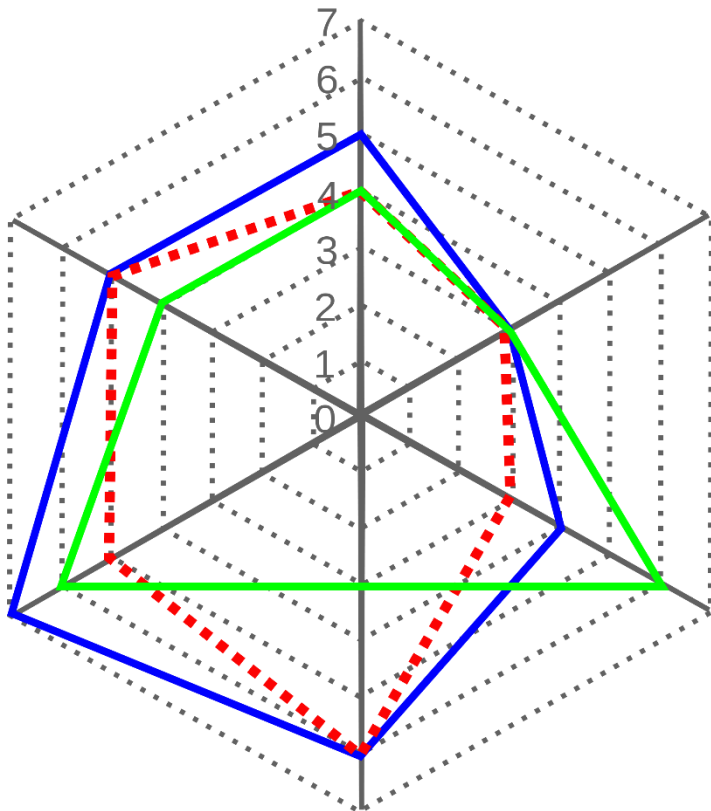

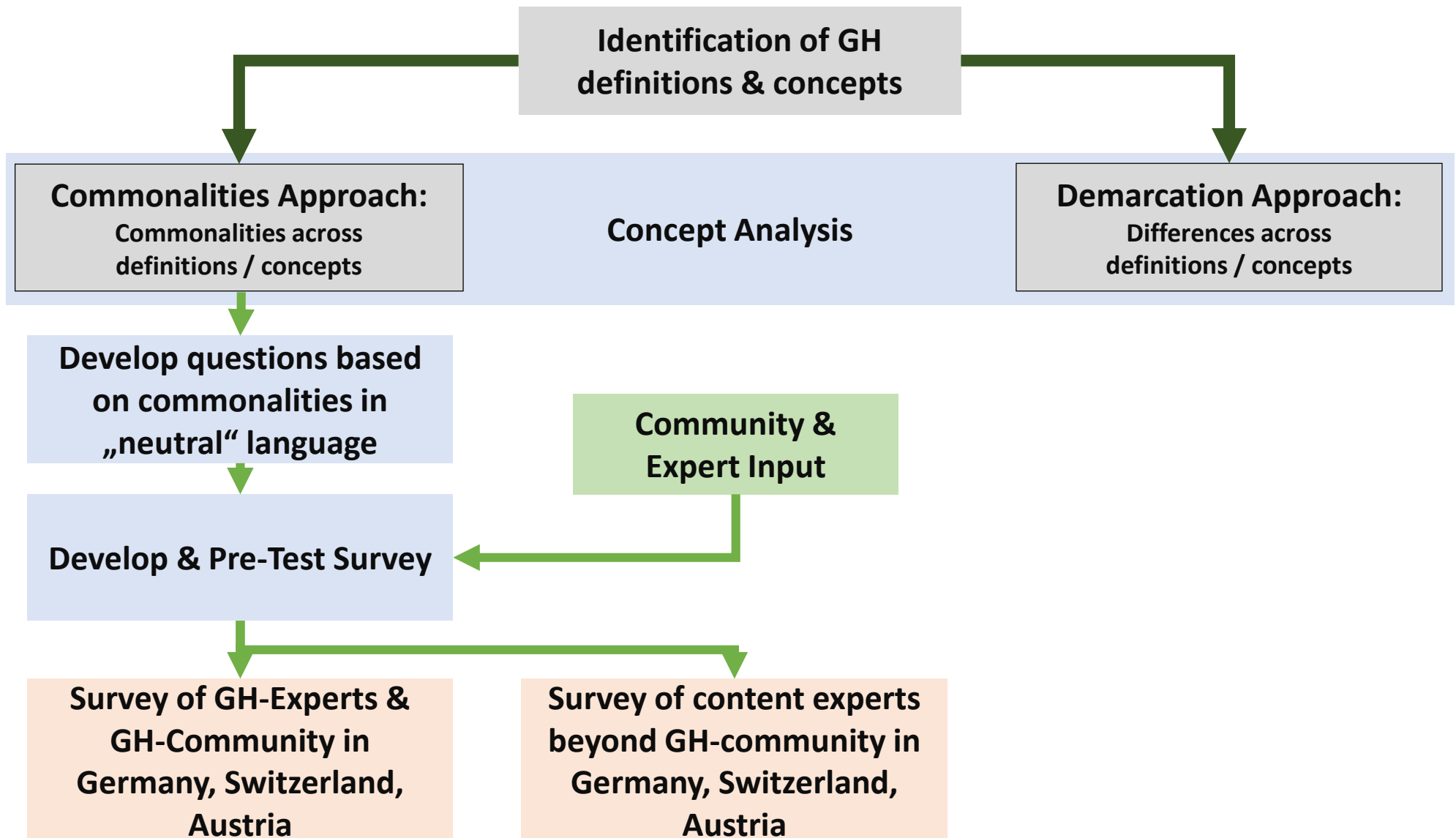
Mapping of Global Health Concepts

 - Clinical research on a new treatment for diabetes

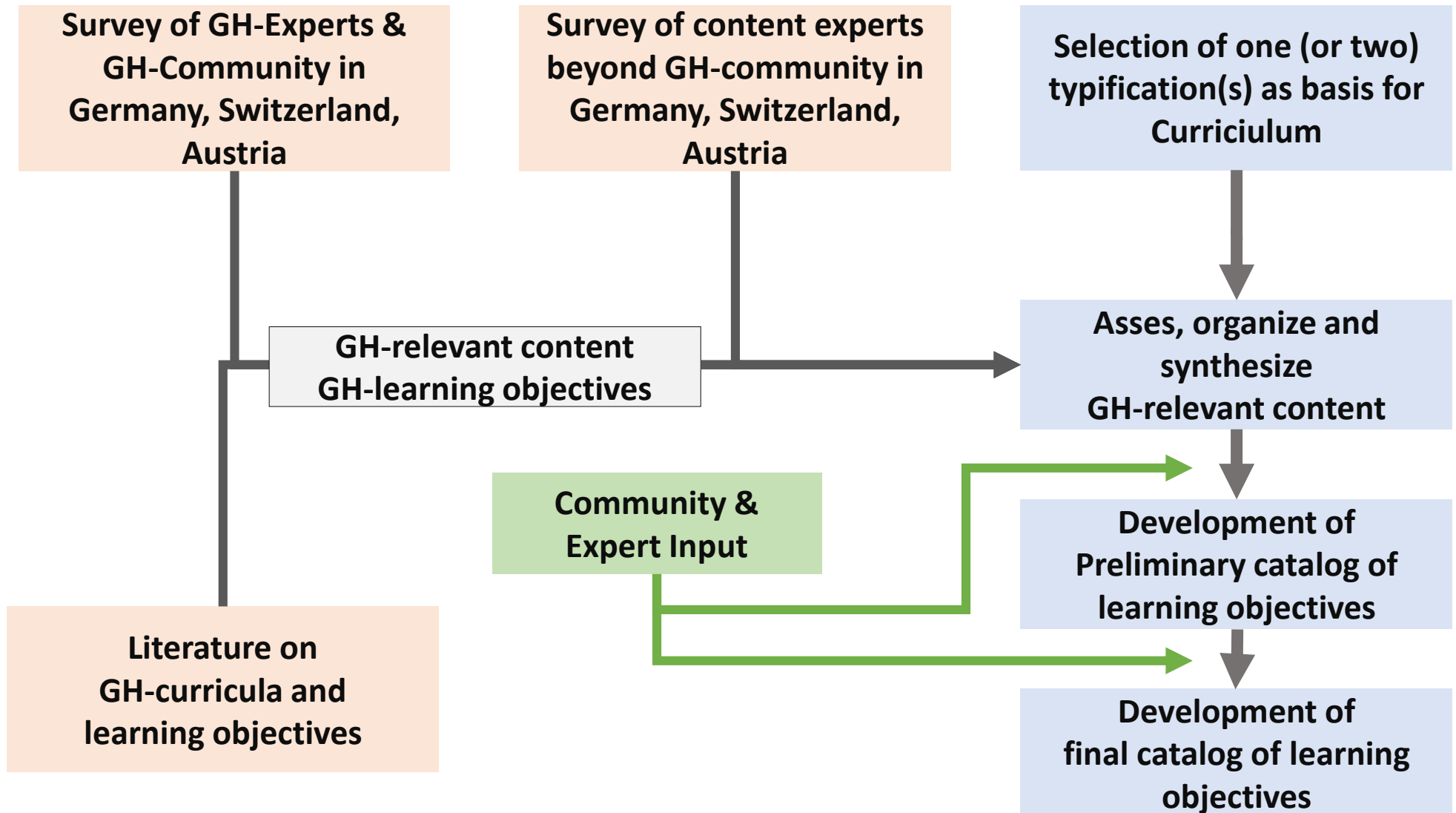

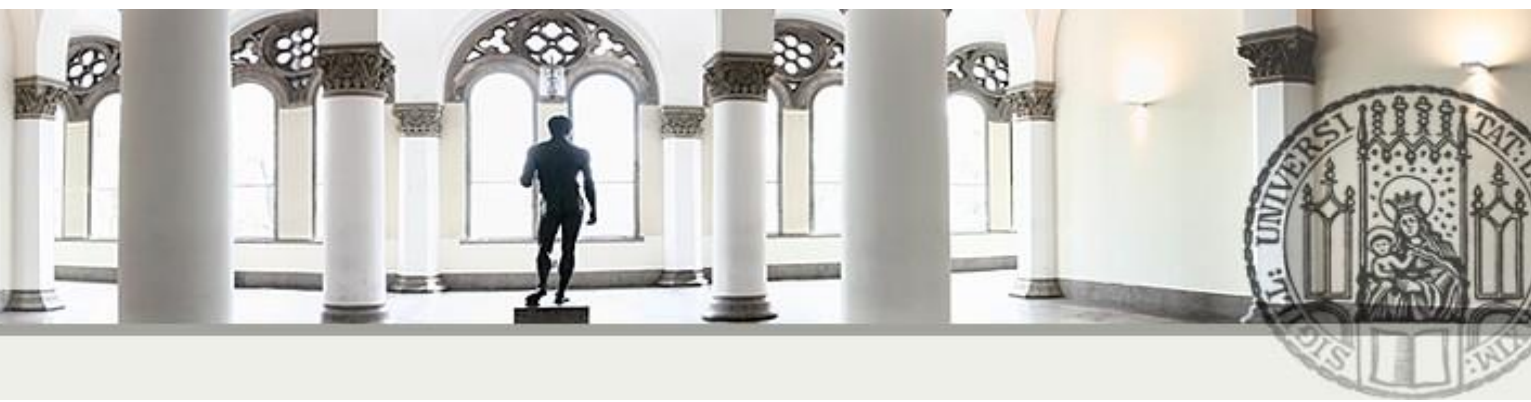
